  - a ALL GUNS ARE ON THE BENCH AND HAVE EMPTY CHAMBERS
  - **b** ALL SLIDES ARE OPEN
  - c -ALL CYLINDERS ARE OPEN & EMPTY
  - d SINGLE ACTION REVOLVERS MUST HAVE THE LOADING GATE OPEN AND THE CYLINDER CHAMBER FLAGGED
  - e ALL MAGAZINES ARE OUT
  - f A SAFETY FLAG INSERTED IN THE BARREL, MAG WELL OR CYLINDER
  - g -A GUN WILL ALSO BE CONSIDERED SAFE IF -BOXED OR BAGGED
  - h A TRIGGER LOCK INSTALLED DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A SAFE GUN
  - I ALL SHOOTERS HAVE STEPPED BACK BEHIND THE SAFETY LINE
  - J THE RANGE OFFICER HAS CHANGED THE RANGE LIGHT TO GREEN AND HAS ANNOUNCED THE LINE IS SAFE
- 16) FIREARMS IN THE RANGE ARE TO BE HANDLED ONLY ON THE FIRING LINE AFTER THE RANGE OFFICER HAS CHANGED THE RANGE LIGHT TO RED AND HAS ANNOUNCED THAT THE RANGE IS ACTIVE
- 17) NO ONE MAY LEAVE OR ENTER THE RANGE WHILE SHOOTING IS IN PROGRESS OR THE RANGE IS ACTIVE
- 18) BLACK POWDER HAND GUNS AND RIFLES ARE NOT ALLOWED
- 19) NON-MEMBERS OF THE N.F.R.C. ARE ALLOWED TO SHOOT WIH DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A MEMBER OF THE N.F.R.C.

## NOTE -

**DIRECT SUPERVISION MEANS:-**

ONE ON ONE SUPERVISION - IF A GUEST IS SHOOTING. THE SPONSORING N.F.R.C. MEMBER IS NOT SHOOTING & IF THE MEMBER IS SHOOTING. THE GUEST IS NOT SHOOTING

**20)** WHEN ANY TYPE OF LEAGUE MATCH IS IN PROGRESS, THE RULES OF THE SANCTIONING BODY WILL APPLY. IF MORE THAN ONE RULE IS APPLICABLE, THE STRICTEST SAFETY RULE WILL APPLY
